Job interview - general

1. Collect information about the company

- ← homepage, advertisement
- ← size, services, departments

2. Dresscode

- ← tidy and suitable clothing
- ← don't exaggerate too much



3. Body language

- ← eye contact, but don't stare
- ← pay attention on your body posture

4. Questions you should be prepared for

- ← what are your strong and weak points?
- ← why do you want to work in this position?



Phases during an job interview

1. Smalltalk - Greeting

- ← join in a conversation
- ← be aware, the boss starts
- ← mind the etiquette

2. Self-Presentation

- ← telling important things from your CV
- ← represent your soft and hard skills



3. Company introduces itself

- ← pay attention
- ← important information about the company or workplace

4. Question time

- ← applicant -> to the company
- ← you should have further questions to show your interest
