

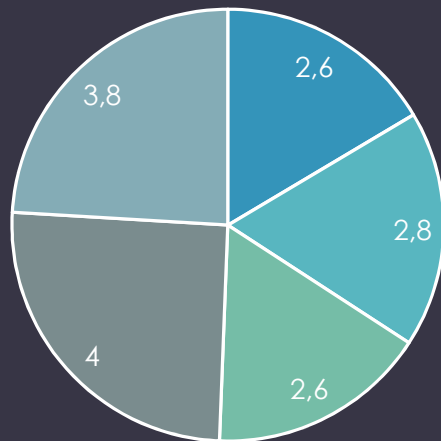

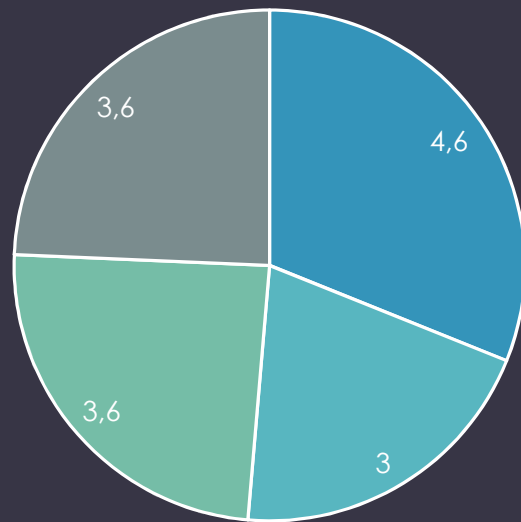
The learning effects for teachers about teaching methods were judged as satisfying.

average



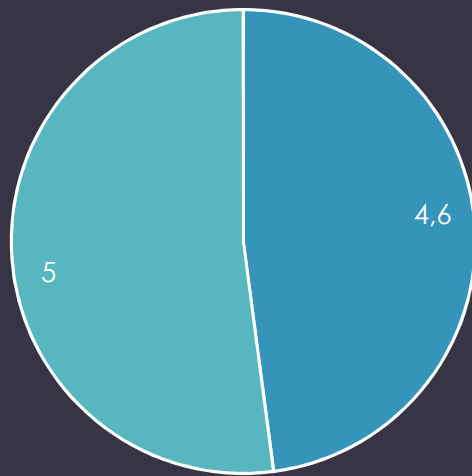

Changes were considered as reasonable.

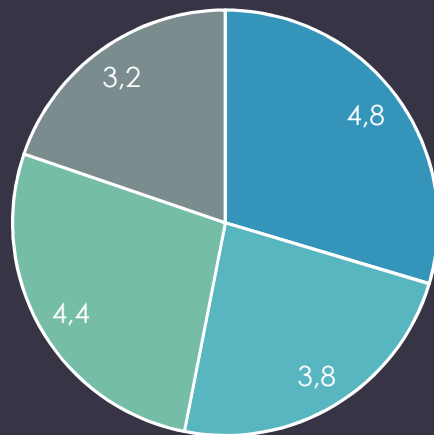
# Category 3: project time schedule

■ writing

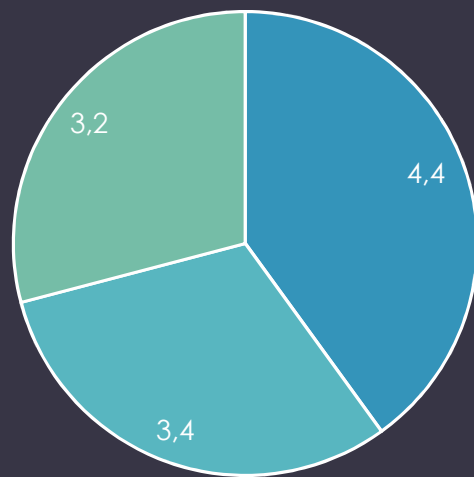
■ translating/mediating
